National

- "Pakistan is poised for an economic takeoff," Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif said at the inauguration ceremony of the Havelian-Thakot Motorway section in Mansehra. The 120kilometre section of the motorway, part of China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), is expected to be completed in 42 months with a cost of Rs133.98 billion. China Exim bank will fund 90 per cent of the project, while the remainder will be funded by Pakistan.
- Yavar Jamalov, Minister of Defence Industry of Azerbaijan, who is on an official visit to Pakistan, called on General Rashad Mahmood, Chairman Joint Chiefs of Staff Committee at Joint Staff Headquarters, Rawalpindi.

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

- Former senator of Awami National Party (ANP) Amarjeet Malhotra has been held for police investigation in relation to the assassination of Pakhtunkhwa CM's Special Assistant on Minority Affairs Sardar Sooran Singh. Amarjeet's name was included in the list of suspects involved in the killing of Singh, by DIG Malakand Division Azad Khan.
- A first year student killed a 9th grader and later committed suicide in Shabgadar tehsil.
- Security forces have arrested three alleged terrorist believed to be linked to massacre of ten tourists at the base camp of Nanga Parbat.
- Two death row convicts were hanged in the Central Jail <u>Haripur</u>. The bodies of the prisoners were handed over to their families after the execution.

Punjab

- General Raheel Sharif, Chief of Army Staff, witnessed today the ongoing maneuver exercise of a
 Corps, near Jhelum. The exercise is being conducted in an overall framework of effectively
 repulsing enemy offensive through integrated application of artillery, air and combat aviation
 firepower. COAS expressed complete satisfaction over the high standard of operational
 preparedness and appreciated the professional skills displayed by the participating troops.
- The Counter Terrorism Department (CTD) Punjab claimed to have apprehended an alleged terrorist from Sargodha. CTD also recovered large cache of weapons from the terrorist.
- A man slit the throats of two women after raping one of them in a village of <u>Talagang</u> tehsil, police said. SHO Naiyar Abbas told that one of the women was married and had three children, he also told that the man escaped after killing women and police will soon arrest him.
- A woman was set ablaze by unidentified accused in <u>Muridke</u>. Police said that Nazia Bibi's husband Shahid Kamboh, a businessman, had also been murdered by unidentified killers 18 months ago. She was pursuing her husband's murder case.

Sindh

- Police conducted search operation in <u>Korangi</u>, Karachi and released young girl who was allegedly kidnapped from Rahim Yar Khan. One man and a woman have been arrested on the charges of kidnapping, SSP Police said.
- A fresh polio case was reported in Sindh's Shikarpur district, bringing the year's total to eight cases. Deputy Health Officer Shikarpur Dr Qazi Khursheed Ahmed told that a sample collected from four-year-old confirmed that the child had polio.
- A private television channel's team was arrested from Sindh Assembly premises after a team member took a gun inside in order to expose substandard security arrangements at the building.
- A 55-year-old retired Major Imran Jawed was found dead in his room in Mehran Hotel, Karachi with a gunshot wound in his head. He had arrived from Lahore and checked in at the hotel at 9.30pm. He was found dead with a bullet wound on his head. The police were informed about the incident at 3pm next day, Police official said.

Balochistan

- The Afghan officer named Rozi Khan reportedly a second lieutenant in the intelligence unit of
 the Afghan army was arrested by Fedral Intelligence Agency (FIA) officials in <u>Chaman</u> over
 charges of crossing the border without possessing any authentic travel documents to enter into
 Pakistan, Officials said.
- According to police, a man along with his son riding a bike was on way when their motorcycle
 was hit by a landmine blast in village Goth Ghori, <u>Dera Murad Jamali</u>, as a result the man died
 on the spot and his son received critical wounds. The deceased and the injured were shifted to
 hospital.
- Frontier Corps (FC) detained a suspect and recovered Kalashnikovs from his custody in Amir Khail area of Zhob district.
- Unknown armed men shot dead a man in Zhob town, Levies force said.

International

- The United States (US) administration is withholding funds earmarked for Pakistan's purchase of eight F-16 fighter jets, BBC Urdu reported, citing an unnamed senior US State Department official. The State Department official told BBC Urdu on condition of anonymity that the Obama administration is still willing to sell the fighter jets to Pakistan, but will not contribute US funds towards the deal.
- An Australian woman working for a charity in Afghanistan has been kidnapped, the country's foreign minister said. Julie Bishop said Canberra was working to secure the release of Katherine Jane Wilson, but insisted Australia does not pay ransoms for hostages.
- The Turkish military returned fire on Islamic State positions in northern Syria, killing 11 members of the militant group, military officials said.
- Italian police issued arrest warrants for six people suspected of conspiring to join the militant Islamic State, and court documents said three of them had been discussing possible attacks on the Vatican and the Israeli embassy in Rome.
- Captain Kristen Griest became the United States (US) Army's first female infantry officer this
 week, the Army said, in a milestone for the US military as it opens up combat roles for women.
