National

- Chief of Army Staff General Raheel Sharif confirmed the death sentences of 11 convicts tried by military courts. The 11 "hardcore terrorists" were "involved in committing heinous offences related to terrorism", which include killing and kidnapping civilians, attacks on the armed forces and law enforcement agencies and destruction of schools and communication infrastructure. Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) said.
- ISPR spokesperson Lieutenant General Asim Bajwa confirmed the suspension of six army officers by the Chief of Army Staff as part of the "army's aggressive pursuit of an anti-corruption drive".

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

- The federal government has decided to give the status of town and municipal committee to all the tehsils and agency headquarters of the Federally Administered Tribal Areas in order to ensure provision of better civic facilities to the people there.
- Police and security agencies conducted operation in <u>Kohat</u> and arrested 37 suspects, also recovered large cache of weapons.
- Police arrested a smuggler of arms from <u>Peshawar</u> and recovered a huge cache of arms and ammunitions.
- Police conducted search operation in <u>Mardan</u> and arrested 2 terrorists.
- Curfew has been imposed in <u>Mohmand Agency</u> owing to worsening security situation. Security forces have already banned motorcycle riding in the agency since the last 10 days.

- At least six schools in various parts of Lahore were evacuated and closed for the day following a series of hoax calls about a bomb threat, police said.
- Two sisters were stabbed and seriously injured by an unidentified man on <u>Durand Road</u>, Lahore.
- A man convicted of killing six persons has been hanged to death in district jail Sargodha.

Sindh

- Chief of Army Staff (COAS) Gen Raheel Sharif has ordered an inquiry into the death of Mutahidda Qaumi Movement (MQM) activist Aftab Ahmed, who reportedly died in the custody of Rangers paramilitary force.
- Sindh Chief Minister Syed Qaim Ali Shah signed the summary of extending the powers of Rangers under the Anti-Terrorism Act for 77 days.
- Police conducted search operation in Pakistan Bazar, Karachi and arrested 2 alleged terrorists.
- Police conducted raid in <u>Maripur</u>, Karachi and arrested 2 wanted criminals involved in sectarian and target killings.
- A sessions court indicted a senior police officer in a case pertaining to the murder of his wife. Superintendent of Police Mian Jamshed Inamullah was booked for allegedly killing his wife, in their home in Defence Housing Authority.

International

- Opposition Labour candidate Sadiq Khan had a strong lead in final polls before London mayoral elections, putting him on course to become the first Muslim leader of a European Union capital.
- The militant Islamic State (IS) group broke through Kurdish defences in northern Iraq and killed a US Navy SEAL deployed as part of the US-led coalition against the militants.
- U.N. backed peace talks to end Yemen's civil war resumed after these were suspended by the Yemeni government in protest at a Houthi assault on a military base in the capital Sanaa.
