National

- Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif has decided to induct National Party chief Senator Mir Hasil Khan Bizenjo in the federal cabinet and he would take oath of his new responsibilities on Monday.
- Pakistan needs modern F-16 fighter jets for its ongoing war against terrorism but rejects the conditions the United States has attached with their sale, said Foreign Secretary Aizaz Chaudhry.
- Foreign Office of Pakistan expressed concern over the dismissal of Bangladesh Jamaat-i-Islami chief Motiur Rehman Nizami's final appeal against death sentence awarded to him by a controversial war crimes tribunal for his involvement in 1971 events.

International

- A US congressional panel has endorsed a draft bill that seeks to block \$450 million in aid to Pakistan for failing to take action against Afghanistan's militant Haqqani Network.
- The US State Department has urged Pakistan to take military action against Taliban leaders who allegedly used its territory for cross-border attacks, besides continuing to encourage them to resume peace talks with Kabul.
- India's opposition Congress party staged a show of defiance, with Sonia and Rahul Gandhi leading a rally and march to parliament to resist what they called Prime Minister Narendra Modi's bid to destroy democracy.
- The whistleblower behind the Panama Papers, known as 'John Doe', has offered to make the documents behind the leaks available to government authorities and called for better whistleblower protection.
- Opposition Labour lawmaker Sadiq Khan was elected mayor of London with 57 per cent of the vote, making him the first Muslim mayor of London.
- Seven people were killed and more than 15 wounded by a bomb in the Yemeni city Marib, east of the capital Sanaa, police said.
