## Daily Security Report

### National

- Pakistan has formally asked the US administration and Congress to support its application for joining the Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG). In a letter to the US Senate Committee on Foreign Relations, Pakistan's Ambassador Jalil Abbas Jilani reminded Congress that Pakistan had taken a series of steps that qualify it for joining the NSG.
- Pakistan urged Nuclear Suppliers Group member countries to adopt objective and non-discriminatory criteria to award membership.
- Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif is likely to return to Pakistan after Eidul Fitr, as he plans to spend the last ten days of Ramazan in Makkah and Madina.
- President Centre for Pakistan and Gulf Studies Senator Sehar Kamran (TI) has expressed concern at India's inclusion into the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR).

## **Punjab**

- Pakistan Awami Tehreek (PAT) chief Dr Tahirul Qadri announced to stage sit-in at Mall Road on June 17 to demand justice for martyrs of Model Town.
- A Ramazan Bazaar set up in [Chenab Nagar](#) has attracted attention of some self-described anti-Ahmadia campaigners who persuaded the district administration to relocate it, and are now threatening public agitation if the facility isn't shifted away from land owned by the Jamaat-i-Ahmadia.
- A teenage girl was burned alive by her mother in the name of 'honour' for marrying a man of her choice in Lahore's Factory area.
- As many as 42 Pakistanis deported by Turkish government reached [Sialkot](#). Reports said 42 stranded Pakistanis were detained by security forces, while crossing border illegally to reach Jordan with the help of human traffickers.
- An anti-terrorism court awarded death sentence to three men who were convicted for killing Additional District and Sessions Judge Muhammad Tahir Khan Niazi during a robbery incident in Rawalpindi.

### International

- Pakistan High Commissioner to India Abdul Basit was stopped from participating in a diplomatic meeting organised by United Nations in Nagpur. The envoy was invited as a chief guest but when he arrived at the venue, he was barred from entering the hall.
- Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi called for a closer security relationship between his country and the United States, in an address to the US Congress he stressed the importance of warm relationship between the two countries.
- A senior leader of the Haqqani network was killed in a United States drone strike in Afghanistan's Paktika province. The leader killed in the drone strike was Sirajuddin Khademi, a logistics commander of the Haqqani network and member of the Quetta Shura.
- India has stepped up efforts to sell an advanced cruise missile system to Vietnam and has at least 15 more markets in its sight.
- An American company will build six nuclear reactors in India under an agreement announced after a White House meeting between Indian and US leaders.
