International

- Pakistan and India need to pursue closer relations on security front to counter threat of terrorism, a US Statement Department spokesman said, stressing that the United States need to seek closer ties between both countries.
- The United States has asked Pakistan to put its case before all 48 members of the Nuclear Suppliers Group, instead of seeking individual endorsements for joining the NSG.
- An Indian charity worker has been kidnapped in Kabul, officials said, the latest in a wave of abductions of foreigners in the war-battered country.
- Islamic State claimed responsibility for suicide and car bomb blasts that struck a Damascus suburb near Syria's holiest Muslim shrine, and a monitoring group said at least 20 people were killed.
