- Britain's Prince Charles visited Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif at his London residence and inquired about his health.
- Adviser to Prime Minister on Foreign Affairs Sartaj Aziz said Pakistan's credentials for the membership of Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG) are stronger than India's if the 48-nation cartel agrees to form a uniform criteria for non-NPT states.
- Chief of Army Staff General Raheel Sharif and his wife sent flowers and a card to philanthropist and chairman of Edhi Foundation Abdul Sattar Edhi. The gesture comes as news of Edhi's deteriorating health has caused worry, drawing well-wishers and offers of assistance.

International

- China said that more talks were needed to build a consensus on which countries can join the main group controlling access to sensitive nuclear technology, after a push by the United States to include India.
- Chinese authorities say three people have been injured by a small explosion at the check-in area of Shanghai's Pudong airport.
- Fifty people died and another 53 were injured when a heavily-armed gunman opened fire and seized hostages at a gay nightclub in Orlando, Florida, police said, in the worst mass shooting in US history.
- England fans rioted at the Old Port in Marseille and police used tear gas for a third straight day in an attempt to disperse rowdy crowds only hours before England was to play Russia at the European Championship.
