Balochistan

- A police officer serving with Balochistan's counter-terrorism department (CTD) was gunned down on <u>Sariab Road</u>, officials said.
- A militant blew himself up and two others were arrested during a search operation carried out by Frontier Corps near <u>Zhob</u>.
- Pakistan Coast Guards (PCG) arrested at least 53 Iran-bound immigrants in Balochistan and handed them over to Federal Investigation Agency (FIA).

International

- The United States warned against the risk of a nuclear conflict in South Asia, as China called for more talks on India's application seeking membership of an exclusive club of nuclear suppliers. A senior US official, however, disagreed with the suggestion that India's entry into the Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG) would affect strategic stability in South Asia.
- Nihad Awad, executive director of the Council on American-Islamic Relations, called for unity and urged politicians not to "exploit" the slaughter in Orlando, which left 50 dead and dozens more injured.
- Islamic State claimed responsibility for the shooting that killed at least 50 people at a gay nightclub in Orlando Florida, in an official broadcast on the group's Albayan Radio.
