#### National

- Pakistan is considering a Jordanian offer to buy sixteen used F-16 jets in lieu of the eight advanced fighters it could not buy from the United States because of a financing row.
- Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif has finalised the list of candidates who will represent PML-N seats in Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJK) Elections to be held on June 26. PM Nawaz Sharif re-iterated that the Party's stance revolves around 'Good Governance'.
- Pakistan continues with diplomatic efforts to muster support for its application for membership of the Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG). In this regard, Adviser to the Prime Minister on Foreign Affairs, Mr. Sartaj Aziz, today made telephone calls to H.E. Sebastian Kurz, Foreign Minister of Austria and H.E. Mevlut Cavusoglu, Foreign Minister of Turkey.

## Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

- Chief of Army Staff (COAS) General Raheel Sharif visited forward locations in North and South Waziristan and spent whole day with the tribes and troops busy in consolidation phase of Operation Zarb-e-Azb.
- An army officer, who was injured by Afghan firing at the Torkham border on Monday, succumbed to his injuries at the Combined Military Hospital in Peshawar. Major Ali Jawad's funeral was attended by Chief of Army Staff General Raheel Sharif in Peshawar.
- The death of Pakistani army officer, after being shot by Afghan forces in a clash across Torkham border, is likely to ratchet up tension between the two neighbouring countries who officials said were beefing up troop numbers on either side.
- Unidentified terrorists opened fire at a police mobile in <u>Kabal</u> area near Swat, injuring three police officials.
- The transgender people took to the streets here against the attack on their community member and demanded early arrest and punishment of the gunmen. The rally began from outside <u>Mansehra</u> Press Club and ended outside the urban police station after passing through various roads.

#### International

- Republican Donald Trump placed responsibility for the mass shooting in Florida squarely at the feet of radical Muslims, who he said were entering the country amidst a flood of refugees and "trying to take over our children." Pointing to specific incidents such as the Sep 11, 2001, attacks, Trump said threats were posed by people with roots in Pakistan, Saudi Arabia and Somalia.
- Hundreds of Muslims in New York came together to pray for the victims who lost their lives in the deadliest attack of the United States in a gay nightclub.
- The US gunman who launched the worst terror attack on American soil since 9/11 at a gay nightclub in Orlando was radicalized by Islamist propaganda, officials said, amid reports he was a club regular.
- A man who claimed allegiance to the militant Islamic State group stabbed a French policeman to death on Monday night before he was killed in a dramatic police operation, police official said.
