National

- Pakistan is looking to hire lobbying firms in Washington after a gap of nearly eight years, seeking to refurbish its image in the United States at a time of deteriorating relations between the allies, two government officials told Reuters.
- Addressing a press conference on the two-year anniversary of Operation Zarb-i-Azb, Director General Inter-Services Public Relations Lieutenant General Asim Bajwa presented major achievements of the operation so far – listing progress made on various fronts.
- Pakistan's benchmark index jumped as much as 3 per cent in early trade, climbing to a record high after the country's stock market was reclassified overnight and included in the MSCI's emerging market index category. The index recorded its biggest single-day gain since March 31, 2015, and is one of Asia's best performers this year.

International

- Human Rights Watch, a prominent international watchdog body, has asked the Pakistani
 government to send a message of "zero tolerance" by urgently investigating and prosecuting
 those responsible for the recent spate of "honour" killings in the country.
- Afghan President Ashraf Ghani chaired the National Security Council (NSC) meeting in Kabul amid tense situation at Torkham, Afghan media reported.
- An information technology worker at the Geneva office of Mossack Fonseca, the law firm at the centre of the Panama Papers scandal, has been arrested, Switzerland's Le Temps newspaper reported.
- U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry said he had discussed ways to revive a "frayed" Syrian truce and get aid into besieged communities with Iranian Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif, who had indicated "how this can be achieved".
