National

- Iranian government has finally responded to a letter written by the interior ministry seeking investigation into Indian intelligence agency RAW's network in Iran. According to an official statement, progress in expansion of cooperation in a number of areas, including security, was reviewed during the meeting which also took stock of the situation prevailing in the region.
- The US Senate has passed its draft of the National Defence Authorisation Bill, including a provision to set up a new fund to reimburse Pakistan for its efforts in the war against terrorism. The Senate version authorises \$800 million under a provision called the 'Pakistan Security Enhancement Authorisation'.

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

- At least one person was injured in an explosion outside the [Mardan](#) residence of former chief minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Ameer Haider Khan Hoti, police said.
- Two people were killed and more than 44 suffered injuries when stormy winds blowing at the speed of 95 kilometres per hour and heavy downpour hit Peshawar and its surrounding districts.
- Four female students sustained injuries when a watchman at their school 'unintentionally' fired a bullet from a 12-bore gun in [Madyan](#) area of Swat.

Sindh

- Former petroleum minister Dr Asim Hussain's lawyer claimed that his client's confessional video statement against Owais Muzaffar alias Tappi – that was aired on local television channels last night – was obtained by force.
- An antiterrorism court of Karachi issued warrants against the Muttahida Qaumi Movement chief and other party leaders in a 1997 triple murder case.
- Police conducted search operation in [Sarjani Town](#) and arrested a suspect Afghan national.
- A Hafiz-i-Quran bakery owner was shot dead in a suspected sectarian attack in [Shah Faisal Colony](#), police said.
- An ATC, Karachi sentenced two militants to seven years in prison in explosives cases.

International
